Student progress is our primary focus, regardless of achievement level, and we are always looking for ways to incorporate families in this endeavor.

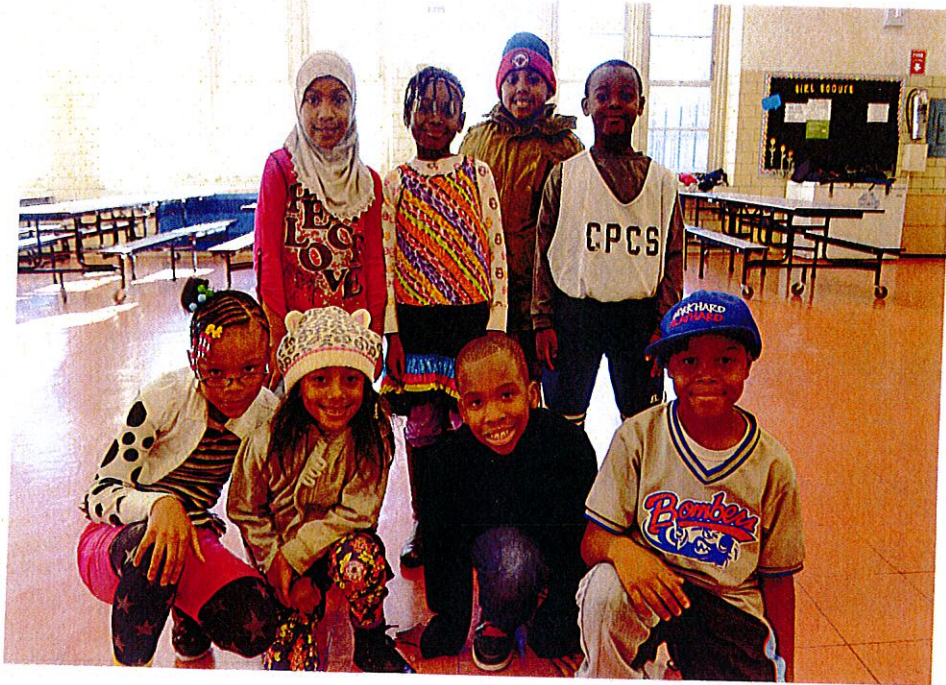
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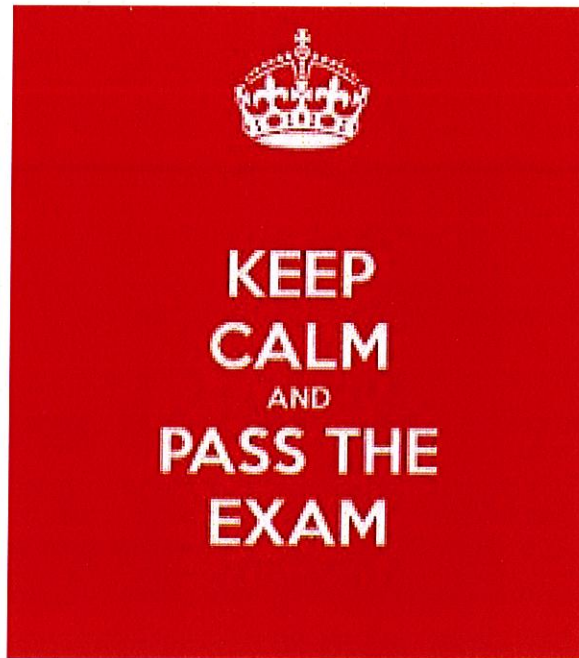


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What: Testing and the Common Core Parent Workshop

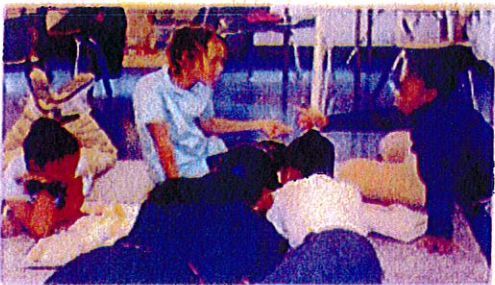
